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### **NEW AMERICAN MARITIME CONGRESS WEBSITE GOES LIVE**

WASHINGTON, DC – The American Maritime Congress announced today that its newly revamped website has gone live. The site, which replaces the old AMC website, was designed to be a “one-stop shop” for information on the United States Merchant Marine for use by the general public and Congress.
